

# SVdP 2019 End of Year Report

1. In 2019 the SVdP Society at OLR provided the following assistance to the needy in the area:
  - a. We served 1500 clients in the food pantry. The pantry is open 4 Saturdays per month. We received from Harvest Hope 30,342 lbs. of food at a cost of \$840. In addition, we received via food drives another 3,000 lbs. of food.
  - b. We prepared and delivered 70 Thanksgiving food baskets to the needy in the area at a cost of \$1000.00.
  - c. As part of the financial assistance ministry, 91 clients were assisted with their utility bills at a cost of \$9400.
  - d. Assisted the MTH ministry by providing financial assistance for dental services for clients on a monthly basis for a total of \$1100.00.
  - e. Twenty homebound ministers visited a total of 280 homebound parishioners to bring them Holy Communion or to take them to Mass.
  - f. SVdP donated food and members volunteered at the Christmas in the Park celebration for the needy in Greenville.
  - g. Number of volunteers that donated their time to serve the needy: 80
  - h. Total number of volunteer hours donated in 2019: 1120
  - i. SVdP worked with Greenville County picking up trash along James Drive and around the church property each month.
